## The speaker?

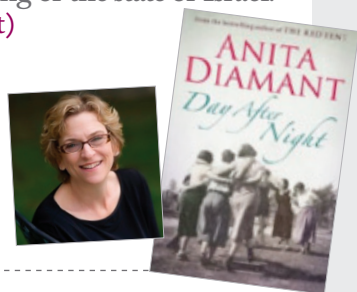
Diamant's writing career began in Boston in 1975. Diamant's first book was *The New Jewish Wedding*. She followed the wedding book with five more guidebooks to Jewish life & lifecycle events. In 1997, Diamant published her first work of fiction, *The Red Tent*, inspired by a few lines from Genesis. The book became a word-of-mouth bestseller and in 2001, the independent booksellers alliance honored *The Red Tent* as its "Booksense Best Fiction" selection. Her latest book, *Day After Night* returns to the land of *The Red Tent* to tell the stories of women who lived through the Holocaust and await the future in a British internment camp. It is a story of loss, hope and courage set in the days before the founding of the state of Israel. **(Signed copies of books will be on offer at the event)**
